

Oldfield learns super experience

SEATTLE [AP] — Television has taught him that maybe it's better to be a master at one trade than a jack of them all, Brian Oldfield is saying after his TV Superstar experience.

Professional trackman Oldfield finished fifth in the smorgasboard sports gimmick, but picked up \$5,400.

"I found out in the Superstars that a superstar in one sport is not all that magnificent in another sport," said the world's shot put record holder. "If a boxer, say, came to me and said he was going to challenge me in the shot, I'd laugh."

ON THE OTHER hand, Oldfield is mulling over a \$35,000 offer to box Ken Norton in Monte Carlo in June.
